**FROG'S BREATH AHBA TRIAL
HERDING RANCH DOG SHEEP (HRDS)
October 28, & 29, 30, 2016**

GENERAL RULES:

- Time 15 minutes
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- Exercise 4 "Fetching, Driving & Outrun," will break ties. 2nd tie breaker will be Exercise 3 "Large Pen & Alley Work." 3rd tie breaker will be Time.

STARTING SET UP:

- Livestock will be held in adjoining fields and pens without visibility screens.
 - The course will begin and must end with five sheep in the holding small holding pen numbered 1 – 6 located inside Pen B. Pens E and J will have five sheep each. Field 5 will have five sheep. All groups of sheep will be marked so they are identifiable as a set.
 - All gates will be closed.
1. **SMALL PEN WORK 10 pts.:** Judge will tell you which is your starting Pen (1 – 6) within Pen B. Time begins when the small holding pen's gate is opened. Remove five sheep from the small holding pen in Pen B holding area. Move them through B & A into E to join the five sheep that are already there.
 2. **SORT 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the gate between Pens A and E is closed. Open gate into the Alleyway so you can sort the sheep using the race and sorting gate. Sort so the five sheep which were originally in Pen E go into the alleyway, the sheep you just brought will remain in Pen E. Close the Alleyway gate.
 3. **LARGE PEN ALLEY WORK 30 pts.:** Exercise begins when the gate between the alleyway and the sorting area is closed. Move the sheep from the alleyway into Pen I. Move the sheep from Field 5 into Field 3. Move the sheep from Pen J into the alleyway. Move the sheep from Pen I into Pen J. Move the sheep out of the Alleyway into Field 5.
 4. **FETCH, DRIVE OUTFRAN HRD I & II 30 pts., HRD III 40 pts.:** Exercise begins when the gate between the alleyway and Field 5 is closed. Put feed into the pan, move the sheep to Pumpkin markers 120 feet across Field 5. Turn the sheep clock- wise between the two Pumpkin markers, the drive the sheep back to the feed pan. Call off, place dog at the appropriate marker for its level; send on the outrun, the fetch will be completed at the Pumpkins. Call the dog off and go into Field 3.
 - **HRD I** - Handlers may accompany sheep as they are moved through the course and obstacle. On the outrun the dog will be placed at the Owl marker, the handler may move within 15 feet of the sheep.
 - **HRD II** - For the drive the handler must remain at Pumpkin marker until the sheep have passed past the owl marker. For the outrun the dog will be placed at Pumpkin marker, the handler may move anyplace between the Pumpkin and Owl markers.
 - **HRD III** - Handlers will remain at Pumpkin marker while the sheep are driven through the panels to the feed pan. The dog will be called back to Pumpkin marker and sent from there on its outrun.
 5. **REPEN 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the gate into Field 3 is closed. Gather sheep and pass through the Long Alleyway, Pens A and B, re-penning in the same small holding area where you began your run. Time ends when the gate to the holding pen is closed.

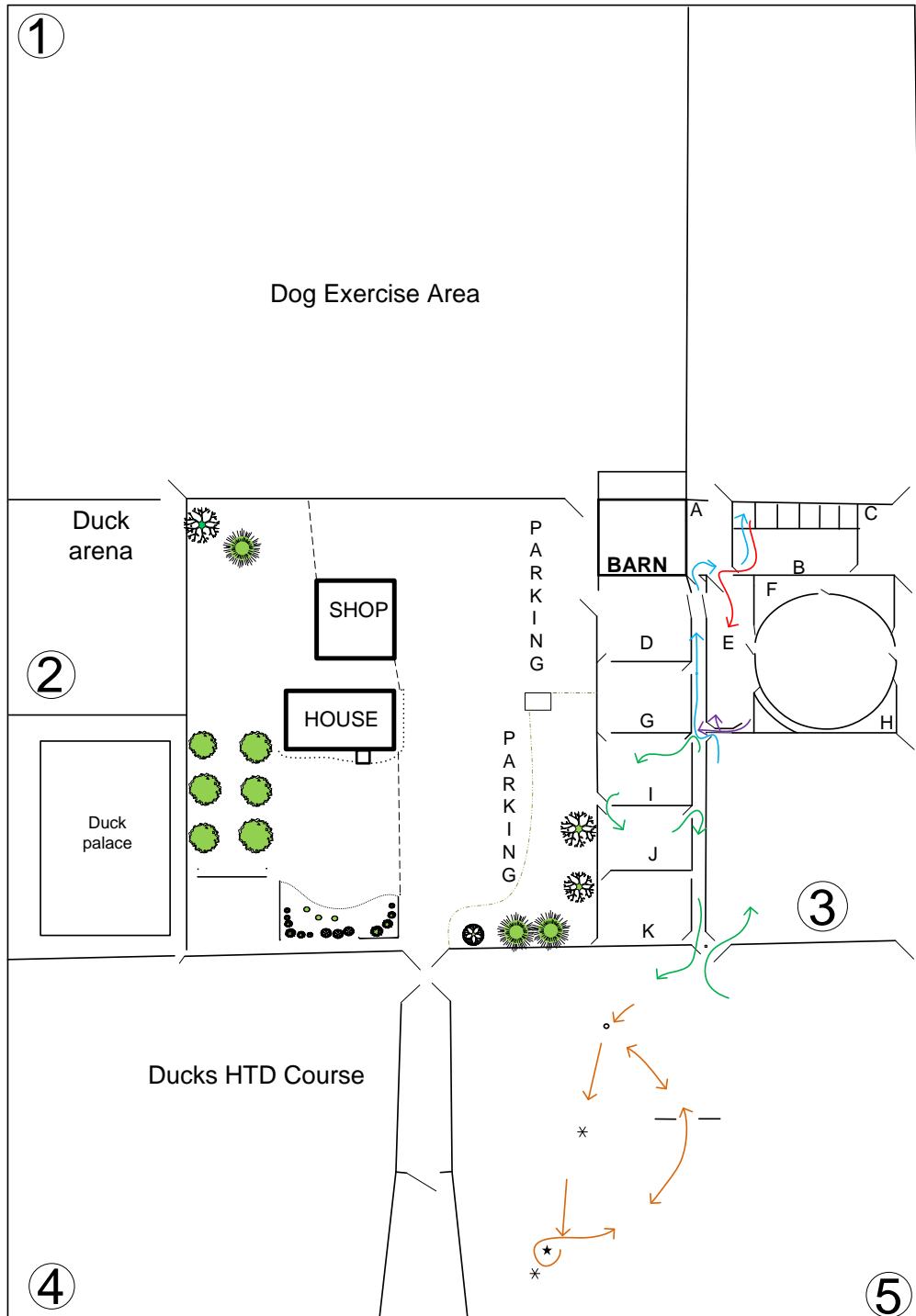
