DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL LOCATION

I-84 West from Boise: Take the Fruitland exit (Hwy. 95) and turn right. Stay on Hwy. 95 North through Payette. From the last stoplight in Payette (Fire station on the right), continue 3 miles north on Highway 95. Turn Left into K-J Ranch.

I-84 from Oregon: Take Ontario exit 396B. Stay right onto Hwy 30 and cross the Snake River to Hwy. 95. Turn left onto Hwy 95 North through Payette. From the last stoplight in Payette (Fire station on the right), continue 3 miles north on Highway 95. Turn Left into K-J Ranch.

Hwy 95 from Nevada: Stay on Hwy. 95 North through Payette. From the last stoplight in Payette (Fire station on the right), continue 3 miles north on Highway 95. Turn Left into K-J Ranch.

Hwy 95 from Cambridge: Stay on Hwy. 95 South through Weiser. Go 7 miles, past the log home factory. After the onion packing plant, turn right into K-J Ranch.

There will be signs for the trial. GPS is not accurate for directions most of the time.

ENTRIES CLOSE at Secretary's office at 6:00 pm Saturday, June 10, 2017, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted. Changes, additions, corrections, or cancellations of entries must be received in writing prior to close of entries. **ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED AND JUDGE AND STOCK SELECTED IF CHOICES ARE OFFERED.** Please check entry form before mailing to make sure it is legible and that all of the dog's titles (AKC titles only) are listed.

ALL ENTRIES ARE TO BE MAILED WITH FEES TO:

NOTE: YOU MAY ENTER THE SAME DOG BOTH DAYS AND ON ALL TYPES OF STOCK ON ONE ENTRY FORM. BE SURE TO INDICATE CLASS FOR EACH STOCK A separate form is required for each dog.

ADDITIONAL NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

No un-entered dogs (except set-out dogs) will be allowed at the trial site. **ABSOLUTELY NO PUPPIES UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY.**

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR OTHERWISE RESTRICTED EXCEPT WHEN WORKING STOCK. Under NO circumstance will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Any dogs aggressive to persons or stock will be removed. (See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the American Kennel Club **HERDING REGULATIONS**).

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED. Please bring your own chairs, shade, etc. Water and soda will be available for sale. All American Kennel Club rules regarding conduct will be strictly enforced.

OWNERS OR THEIR AGENTS are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at test/trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. **NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS WITHOUT THE AGREEMENT AND RULES ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

ENTRIES FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent (unless replaced by an Alternate), disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall be eligible and will run at the end of the class in tests and in catalog order as listed in the class in trials. Notify the Test Secretary if your bitch is in season. (See Chapter 1, Section 3 of the American Kennel Club *Herding Regulations*).
