**Directions to Fido's Farm** 9829 Evergreen Valley Rd SE, Olympia, WA 98513

**From Tacoma and Seattle**

- From I5 take the Old Nisqually exit 116 and get on Old Pacific Hwy until it ends • Turn LEFT onto Hwy 510
- in 1/2 mile turn RIGHT onto Meridian and follow it to the stop sign at Yelm Hwy • Continue straight ahead south on Meridian through a left turn and a right turn • When you see the 20 mph left turn sign turn LEFT onto Evergreen Valley Rd • It is less than 1/2 mile on your RIGHT.

**From Portland**

- Take exit 101 from I5 • Go east (right) on Tumwater Blvd. Stay on it until it ends. • Turn left onto Henderson Blvd • At the stop light turn right onto Yelm Highway -- follow it east about 7 miles • At the 76 station turn RIGHT onto Meridian and follow it south through a left turn and a right turn • When you see the 20 mph left turn sign turn LEFT onto Evergreen Valley Rd • It is less than 1/2 mile on your RIGHT

All breeds can compete in the Stockdog trial, but to receive titles you must either have an ASCA registration number or an ASCA tracking number. All obedience entries must be registered with ASCA or have an ASCA tracking number to compete. All breeds can compete in Junior Handling, but all Juniors going for ASCA merit points must compete with an ASCA registered Aussie that meets ownership requirements and be a Junior member. All regular Aussie conformation entries must have an ASCA registration number. Tracking number applications will be available.

**SITE:**

Fido's Farm is a facility dedicated to dogs and their training. Arenas will be in pastures – if rainy, the ground can be wet, so bring boots. Obedience, Junior Handling and Conformation will be in a mowed grass area. Set ups are allowed, camping available, contact Fido's Farms at 360-866-8347. Dogs are to be on leash unless competing, you are expected to pick up after your dog.

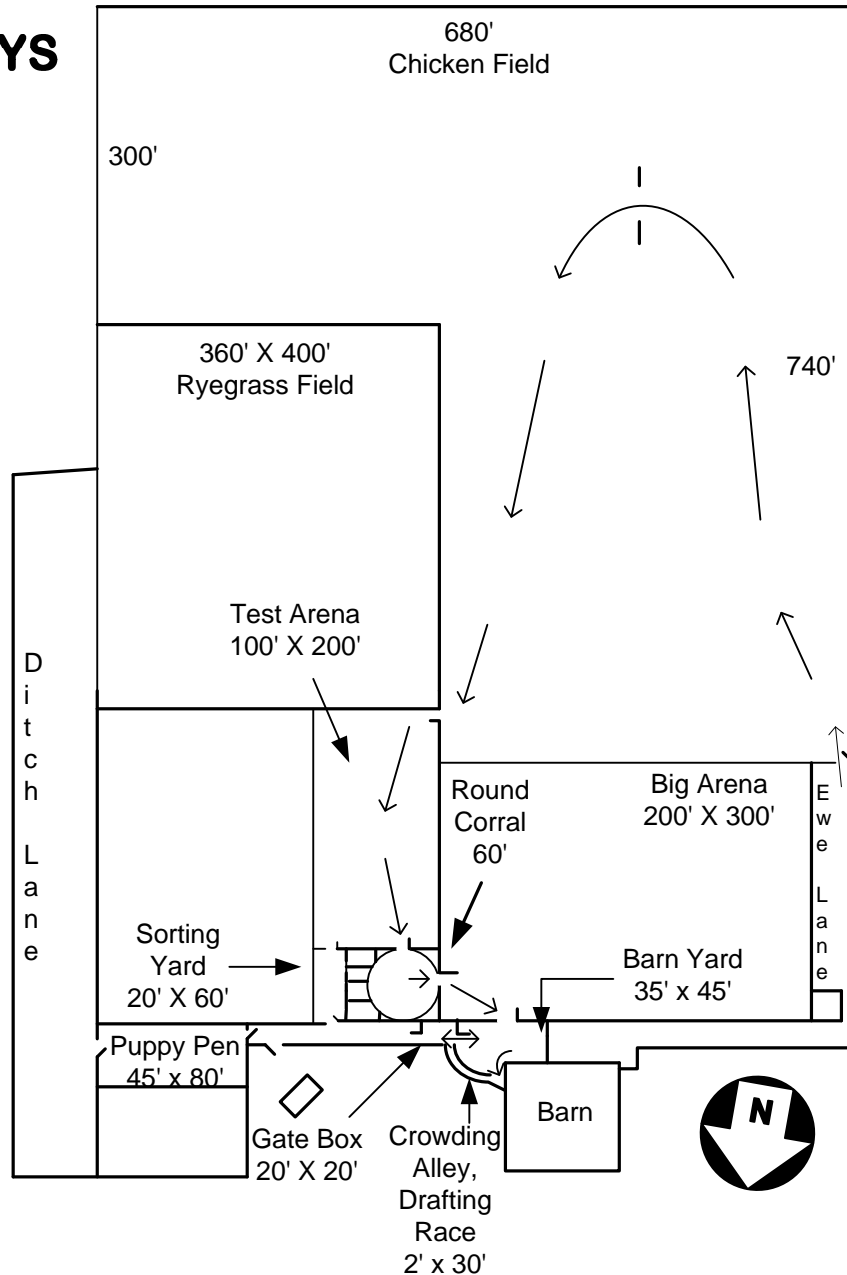
# OLYMPIA DOG DAYS RANCH TRIAL JUNE 3, 2011

Time 20 minutes with two warnings, one at 10 minutes and one at 5 minutes. No gate may be pre-opened prior to the start of the clock. Dog must hold sheep off all gates.

1. **PASTURE WORK** (40 pts.) time starts when the gate from Chicken Field into the Ewe Lane is opened. Gather 15 sheep from Ewe Lane into Chicken Field. Drive or fetch them through the gate in the middle of field.
2. **PEN WORK** (20 pts.) Take sheep through Test Arena, into Round Corral, into Big Arena, and into Barnyard.
3. **SORT** (20 pts.) Gate sort 10 marked sheep into Crowding Alley.
4. **CHUTE** (20 pts.) Load sheep into the Cutting Race. Use guillotine and cutting gates to let first 5 sheep into Barnyard. Stop last 5 sheep with guillotine gate. Let them into the Gate Box. Take sheep from Gate Box into Barnyard. Time ends when Barnyard to Gate Box gate is shut.
