From Tacoma and Seattle:

- Interstate 5 to Exit 116, Mounts Road/Old Nisqually, at end of ramp turn LEFT onto
- Nisqually Rd (Old Pacific HWY) stay on it until it ends, turn LEFT onto
- Hwy 510 (St. Clair Cut-Off Rd SE), travel 1/4 mile, turn RIGHT onto
- Meridian, travel South several miles through the stop sign at Yelm HWY,
- Continue on Meridian through a left turn and a right turn,
- When you see the 20 mph turn LEFT onto
- Evergreen Valley Rd, travel approximately 1/3 mile, Fido's Farm is on the RIGHT.


PackLeader Farm - March 11, 2016 Herding Ranch Dog Sheep (HRDs)

GENERAL RULES:

- Time 20 minutes.
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- Tie breakers, in order, will be Exercise 5 "Take Pen & Obstacle #2", Exercise 7 "Open Movement", Time.

STARTING SET-UP:

- All gates must be returned to the starting positions.
- All gates will be closed and must be closed at the completion of the run;
- 4 groups of (10) sheep in pens behind the round pen.
- 1. GATHER 20 pts.: Time and the exercise begin when the gate to Field 3 is opened. Team will proceed to the position for their level. Gather (10) sheep and move sheep from Field 3 into Field 2. Exercise ends when the sheep enter Field 2.
- HRDI Dog is left behind the HRDII Handler's line, Handler may move within 15 feet of sheep
- **HRDII** Dog is left behind the HRDIII Handler's line, Handler may move up to the HRDII Handler's line.
- **HRDIII** Team begins from behind the HRDIII Handler's line, where the Handler remains until the sheep cross the HRDIII Handler's line.
- 2. OBSTACLE #1 15 pts.: Exercise begins when the sheep enter Field 2. Move sheep through Obstacle #1. Exercise ends when the sheep have cleared the plane of Obstacle #1.
- **3. PEN 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep have cleared the plane of Obstacle #1. Move sheep to the Round Pen and pen. Exercise ends when the sheep are penned and the Round Pen gate is closed.
- 4. <u>HRDIII ONLY</u>: SORT 10 pts.: Exercise begins when the sheep are penned and the Round Pen gate is closed. Sort 5 sheep and release into Holding Pen leaving 5 sheep in the Round Pen. Exercise ends when the team leaves the Round Pen and the gate is closed.
- 5. TAKE PEN & OBSTACLE #2 15 pts.: Exercise begins when the Round Pen gate is closed. Proceed to the Take Pen and remove (10) sheep. Move sheep into Arena C, through Obstacle #2 and into Field 2. Exercise ends when the sheep enter Field 2.
- 6. **OPEN MOVEMENT 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the sheep enter Field 2. Move the sheep across Field 2 and into Field 3. Exercise ends when the sheep enter Field 3.
- 7. FETCH/DRIVE 20 pts.: Exercise begins when the sheep enter Field 3. Fetch/Drive the sheep to the designated Set-Out point. Exercise ends when the sheep reach the designated Set-Out point.
- HRDI Handler may move anywhere
- **HRDII** Handler remains behind the Level II Handler's line.
- **HRDIII** Handler remains behind the Level III Handler's line.




Fido's Farm - March 12, 2016 Herding Ranch Dog Sheep (HRDs)

GENERAL RULES:

- Time: 20 minutes
- All elements must be attempted before moving on
- All gates must be closed and latched unless otherwise stated
- Dog must hold sheep off all gates
- Tie breakers, in order, will be Exercise #5 "tight spaces", Exercise #2 "Drive/Wear", Time

STARTING SET-UP:

- 5 sheep in Big Arena
- 5 Sheep in sort yard pen A or D.
- All gates are shut and latched
- 1. **GATHER 20 pts.:** Time and the exercise begins when handler and dog arrive at Cone A. Gather sheep to Cone A. Move sheep into Chicken field. Exercise ends when Chicken Field gate is closed.
- HRDI Place dog half way between Cone A & sheep. Handler may move to within 15 feet of the sheep.
- **HRDII** Place dog at Cone A. Handler may move half way to sheep.
- **HRDIII** Handler and dog work from Cone A.
- 2. DRIVE / WEAR 25 pts.: Exercise begins when Chicken Field Gate is closed. Drive/wear sheep through freestanding panels to Cone B. Exercise ends when last sheep arrives at Cone B.
- HRDI The handler may walk with sheep throughout.
- **HRDII** The handler may move with sheep to half way to panels.
- **HRDIII** The handler will remain at Chicken Field gate until sheep arrive at Cone B. Dog to hold sheep at cone B until the handler arrives at Maltese Cross.
- FREESTANDING OBSTACLE 15 pts.: Exercise begins when last sheep arrives at Cone B. Move sheep through Maltese Cross in the two directions indicated by the diagram. Exercise ends when last sheep exits second direction of the Maltese Cross.
- SORT <u>HRDIII ONLY</u> 10 pts.: Exercise begins when the last sheep exits the Maltese Cross. Move sheep into the open area. Shed two sheep from the group and show you have control of them. Exercise ends when the judge calls the shed.
- 5. TIGHT SPACES & PENWORK 20 pts.: Exercise begins when the last sheep exits Maltese Cross HRDI & II or when the judge calls the shed. Move sheep through Test Arena then Round Corral into Sort Yard. Both gates, from Round Pen and into Sort Yard, must be open before sheep leave Round Corral. Put sheep into pen A or D, whichever is empty. Remove 5 sheep from other pen, move sheep into Main Alley. Exercise ends when the gate into the Main Alley is closed and latched.
- 6. **REPEN 10 pts.:** Exercise begins when the gate into the Main Alley is closed and latched. Settle sheep at east end of Main Alley. The dog will hold the sheep at the east end while the handler opens the gate into the footbath gate box. Repen sheep through the Footbath. Time ends when the handler closes the Footbath gate box gate.



Frog's Breath Farm - March 13, 2016 Herding Ranch Dog Sheep (HRDs)


GENERAL RULES:

- Time: 20 minutes.
- All elements must be attempted prior to moving on.
- Tie breakers, in order, will be Exercise #2 "Sort," Exercise #5 "Small Pen Work," Time.

STARTING SET-UP:

- There will be sets of (5) five sheep in Field 5, the Round Pen, Pens K, J, I and G.
- All gates will be closed and must be closed at the completion of the run; except the east gate between Fields 3 and 5, which will remain open throughout the day.
- 1. GATHER HRDI & HRDII 20 pts. HRDIII 25 pts.: Time and the exercise begins when the dog is set into motion beginning its gather. Gather sheep from Field 5; move them through the open gate on the east side of Fields 3 and 5 into Field 3, on past the west side of the post. This exercise ends when all the sheep have passed the post.
- **HRDI** The dog will be at the gate between Field 3 and 5. The Handler may walk to within 15 feet of the sheep.
- **HRDII** The dog will be at the post, the Handler my go to the fence between Fields 3 and 5 but may not stand in the gateway.
- **HRDIII** The dog and Handler will be at the post to begin the gather. The Handler will remain at the post until the sheep have passed the post.
- 2. SORT 20 pts.: This exercise begins when all the sheep have passed the post. Move the sheep into the 12 foot alleyway, then into the Round Pen. The dog and Handler will cross the Round Pen, the dog with the Handler and not working the sheep, to the gate opening into Pen E. Gate sort the sheep that were in the Round Pen into Pen E, leaving the sheep you put into the Round Pen. Move the sheep into the 6 foot alleyway and on into Field 5. The dog must cover and hold the sheep while the gate is closed. This exercise ends when the gate is closed.
- 3. DRIVE/WEAR 15 pts. This exercise begins when the gate has been closed. The sheep will be moved across Field 5 to the set of three posts. This exercise ends when the sheep have passed the first of the three posts.
- **HRDI** The handler may accompany the sheep across the field fetching, driving or a combination of either.
- **HRDII** The handler may accompany the sheep to the beginning of the Y chute, and then will drive the sheep.
- **HRDIII** The handler will remain in the gate area until the sheep have reached the posts.
- 4. OBSTACLES HRDI & HRDII 15 pts. HRDIII 20 pts.: This exercise begins when the sheep have passed the first post. Move the sheep first to the east through the first opening then to the west through the second opening. HRDI & HRDII will move the sheep to the Alleyway gate. HRDIII will put the sheep through the Chute, then on to the Alleyway gate. All levels, the sheep will be held off the Alleyway Gate while it is being opened. Put the sheep into the Alleyway and close the gate. The exercise ends when the gate is closed.
- 5. SMALL PEN WORK 20 pts.: The exercise begins when the gate to the Alleyway is closed. Move the sheep from Pen K into Field 5. Move the sheep from Pen J into Pen K; move the sheep from Pen I into Pen J; move the sheep from Pen G into Pen I; Move the sheep from the 6 foot alleyway into Pen G. Time and this exercise ends when all gates are closed.
